Dear Kindergarten Family,

This week we will be reading the book <u>Snowballs</u> by Lois Elhert. (You can watch the story being read if you follow the following link:

https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fU9Je9XCA5g The story begins about 3:34 into the video) In this story, children wait for a "perfect snowball day" to build snow creatures using things they have saved throughout the year.

Please work with your child to help him/her cut out a snow creature shape using the white construction paper provided. Then work together to decorate the snow creature using materials such as nuts, seeds, shells, twigs, bottle caps, ribbon, wall paper samples, wrapping paper, bows, fabric, or any other small items found in your home that could be used to add details. After completing your snow creature, glue it to the blue paper provided.

Complete the writing response page and send it in with the completed project. Please attach this writing to your project so that it can be seen when it is displayed (do not glue it to the back of your project). Remember, this writing response is for your child to do! Please do not write the responses for them (you may help them but not write it for them). If this happens, I will send it home to be completed again.
